

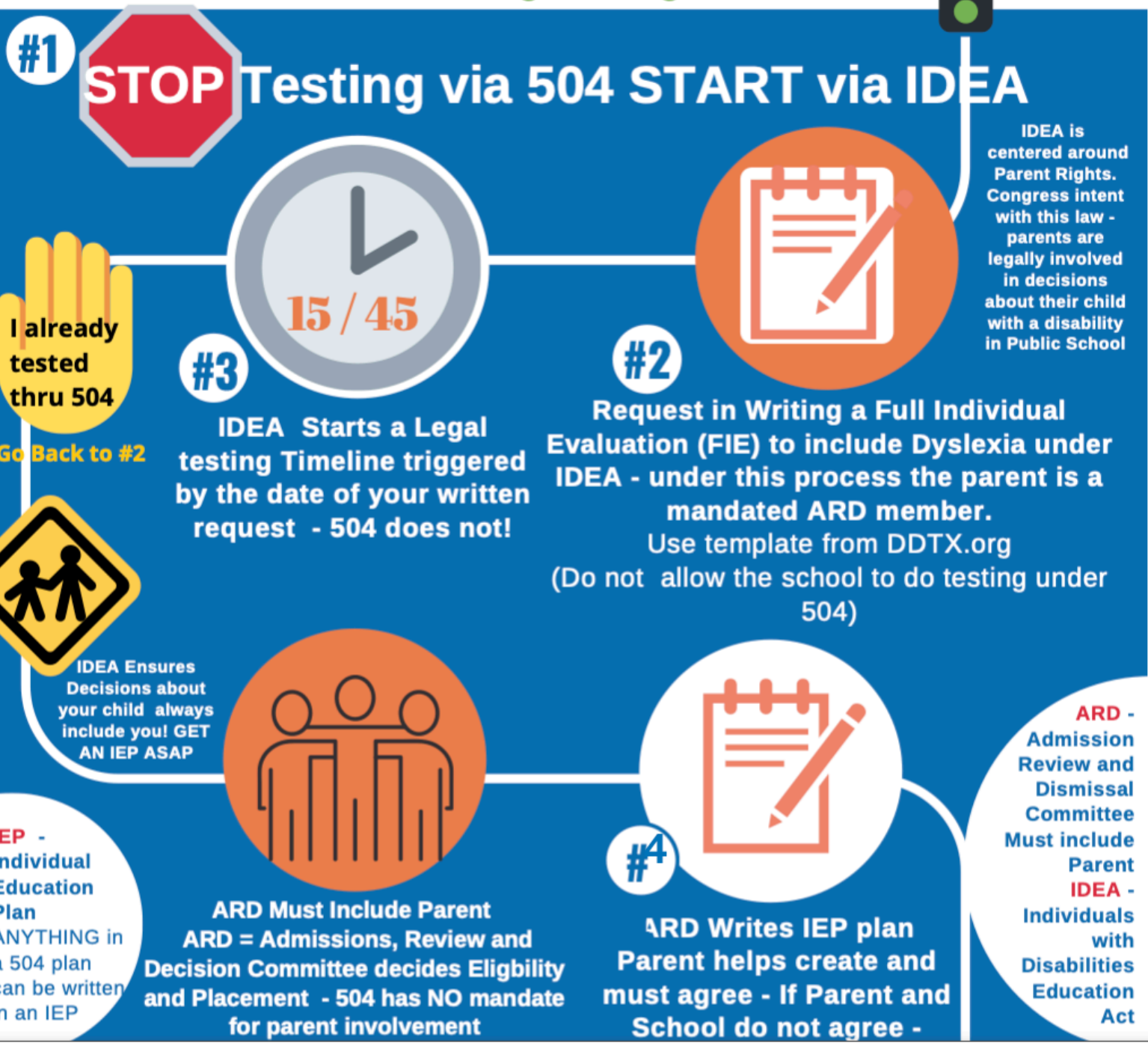

Understand Present Levels of Academic and Functional Performance and Target Appropriately Ambitious Goals to Meet Grade Level Objectives in the IEP

Dyslexia is Legally recognized as a Specific Learning Disability under IDEA - Does Your Dyslexic Student have an **Imperfect Ability** to Read, Write, Spell or Do Math Calculations? That is one way to determine Educational need under SLD

But the school says my child does not NEED Specialized Instruction -or their too smart OR not Severe and won't qualify for SPED

There is NO Severity in Qualifying under SLD if your dyslexic student NEEDS specific dyslexia interventions that IS Educational need for Specialized Instruction



At age 14 an IEP includes Transition Planning for College and Career - Which means an IEP keeping them on track to cross the finish line ready for College and Career



Specific to IDEA

- Right to an Outside Evaluation if you disagree with the school FIE you request a free (IEE)
- Timelines for Evaluation
- IEP spells out exactly the days and time per week that interventions will take place
- Parents are ARD Decision Team Members mandated by IDEA law
- IDEA give parents Rights to seek Private Placement
- IEP = Enforcable Education Plan that Parent creates and agrees to with school
- IEP gives Significant rights for Disciplinary Actions
- If a school doesn't implement the contents of an IEP that is a denial of FAPE and lots easier to prove than a failure to implement a 504 plan
- Rights to Assistive Technology and any related Training on it's use
